The following resolution was presented by C. A. Smart. The Board decided to look over the situation at Baldwin before taking any action.

A resolution for the improvement of High Street in City of Baldwin City, Kansas.

Whereas, the city of Baldwin City, in Douglas County, Kansas, is a city of the third class of less than 65,000 inhabitants, and High Street in said city is an improved paved street at the intersection of said High Street with 9th Street and from the west line of 9th Street to the eastward to the city limits said High Street is unimproved, and

Whereas, said High Street eastward from the city limits to the street commonly called Lawrence Street and said Lawrence Street westward are each unimproved, and

Whereas, the governing body of the said city believes that it is expedient and that a public necessity exists to improve said High Street from the said 9th Street eastward to the city limits and thence for a distance of $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile eastward from the city limits (at Summit Street) to Lawrence Street, thence northward,
