Agreement

This agreement or understanding entered into this 7th day of December 1925 - by and between the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, as first party of the first part and Harold Kennedy and Walter Kennedy as parties of the second part. Whereas Harold Kennedy, the son of Walter Kennedy was injured in an explosion of dynamite, while working for first party on the 18th day August 1925; and whereas none of the parties hereto admit or claim any liability by reason of such accident, yet for the purpose of reaching an understanding concerning said injury the three parties hereto, agree that the party of the first part may and shall pay to Dr. H. L. Chambers the sum of \$83.50 for medical attendance, and to the Simmons Hospital \$137.10 as and for the Hospital bill concerned.
