Supplemental Contract.

This agreement entered into this 4th day of January 1926, supplementing contract dated the 8th day of July, 1925, by and between the Board of County Com. of Douglas County, Kansas, party of the first part and H. A. Marshall, party of the second part.

Witnesseth, that for and in consideration of payment hereinafter contained the party of the second part agrees to make surveys and plans for a Marsh Rainbow Arch across the Wakarusa Creek on F.A.P. 315 near Eudora Kansas. Said plans to meet with the approval of the State Highway Engineer and the U. S. Bureau of Public Roads.

Payments:- The party of the second part agrees to make surveys and furnish plans for the above mentioned bridge for a fee of five (5%) per cent of the approved estimated cost of the structure as approved by the State Highway Eng. Said payment to be made when the plans and estimates are approved by the State Highway Engineer.
