Supplemental Contract

This agreement entered into this 1st day of February 1926, supplementing contract dated 8th day July 1925 by and between the Board of County Comm. of Douglas County, Kansas, party of the first part, and H. A. Marshall consulting Engineer, party of the second part,

Witnesseth, that for and in consideration of payments, hereinafter contained the party of the second part agrees to make surveys and plans for a Marsh Rainbow Arch across the Wakarusa creek on the road south of Lawrence, known as the Lawrence-Ottawa Road F.A.P. 373. Said plans to meet with the approval of the State Highway Engineer and the U.S. Bureau of Public Parks. Payments the party of the second part agrees to make surveys and furnish plans for the above mentioned bridge for a fee of five (5%) percent. of the approved estimated cost of the structure as approved by the State Highway Engineer.
