Saturday February 6-1926

The Board met in adjourned regular session with all members of the Board present.

The monthly reports of Emma J. Kennedy, Com. of Poor, E.R. Keith, Health Officer and G.C. Lizer, Supt of the County Home, were approved. The 4th quarterly report for 1925 of Sheriff, W. J. Cummings was approved.

The Board made the following report on the road petitioned for by Charles Lemon and others (See page 224) "We recommend that the road be relocated and opened 40 feet wide, and that the owner be allowed \$100⁰⁰ per acre damages for land taken for road purpose and \$1⁰⁰ per rod for fence."

The following road petition, signed by John H. Schopper and 17 others was filed with the Board and they appointed themselves as viewers, sitting on the date of view as Wednesday March 3-1926.

"Beginning at a point 20 ft. West of the intersection of the West line of the City limits of Eudora with the South line of road 393 thence South parallel to and 20 ft. West of said city limits and terminating at a point in road 296."

The Board by unanimous vote entered an agreement with George C. Chandler, Architect, to draw plans and prepare specifications for rebuilding the steps around the Court House and Jail, remodeling the rooms wash room and putting in new wash rooms on the second and third floors, and to superintend construction on the same. The fee to be paid for the above work is five per cent of the cost.

Wednesday February 10-1926
