

Monday April 5-1926

The Board met in the first meeting of the April session. Present Chairman K. J. Kennedy, D. L. Burton, G. E. Krutinger, & County Clerk E. C. Buehling. Claims against the county were presented, audited and allowed as per the allowance record.

Wednesday April 7-1926

The Board met in adjourned regular session. Present K. J. Kennedy, D. L. Burton & G. E. Krutinger & the county clerk. Claims against the county were presented, audited and allowed as per the allowance record.

At two o'clock P. M. the Board met in Kanwaka township for the purpose of reviewing the road petition for by J. M. Watts and others, final report was postponed on this road until another meeting of the Board.

Saturday April 10-1926

The Board met in adjourned regular session. Present K. J. Kennedy, D. L. Burton and G. E. Krutinger & County Clerk.

The Board issued the following order. - Instruct the County Treasurer to collect the tax on land in Grant township as follows. 1922 tax. Sale * 31 * 1.57 = 1923 tax Sale * 38 * 1.50 = 1924 Tax. Sale * 21 = 1.27 = 1925 tax. * 1.16 Total \$5.56

This tax was charged on property described as follows - "2 1/2 acres in the N.W. corner of N.W. 1/4 of sec. 18-12-20 and in the name of R. B. Becket. This is in error as this would locate this property on the F. G. Leptist farm, and no land has been deeded from this farm. Oct. 5-1893 we find that the following tract was deeded from Cook to B. B. Becket - "Beg. 66 ch. S. of the N.W. 1/4 of sec. 18-12-20. Thence E. 9.10 ch. - Th. S. 14 ch. - th. W. 150 ch. - th. north 45° W. 11 chains - th. north 6 ch. to beg. containing 9.70 chains." This description was dropped from the tax rolls of 1904 (no doubt because the land was washed away by the 1903 flood and was then in the river). In 1922 the above description of 2 1/2 acres was placed on the tax roll but an error was made in the description placing it in the wrong quarter section. Following the instructions of the Co. Attorney and the order of the County Board, D. E. C. Buehling, Clerk have placed the original description on the tax rolls for 1926.
