School District Change

Whereas a petition dated March 29-1926, signed by twelve resident electors of School Dist. #66, Douglas Co. Kas., asks that said Dist. #66 be disorganized and the territory attached to adjacent school districts, and whereas according to the last census, there are only six children in said Dist. #66 between the ages of five and twenty-one; and whereas there is no record of any bonded, floating, or outstanding indebtedness of any kind:

Therefore said School Dist. #66, Douglas Co. Kansas, is hereby disorganized as provided in Sec. 277 Revised School Laws of 1923, and the territory is attached as follows: S² of Sec. 13; W² of Sec. 24; S² of Sec. 24; N² of Sec. 25; W² of Sec. 25; all in Twp. 14, Range 17 and N² of Sec. 8; and S² of Sec. 17; Twp. 14, R. 18 shall be attached to School Dist. #18, Douglas County, Kas.

N² of Sec. 13; Sec. 14; Sec. 23; N² of Sec. 26; N² of Sec. 25; N² of S. W. of Sec. 25; E² of N. E. of Sec. 24; W² of Sec. 24; Twp. 14, R. 17. Shall be attached to school district no. 32 Douglas Co. Kas.

The County Treasurer of Douglas County, Kansas, is directed hereby to transfer to the credit of School Dist. #18, Douglas Co. Kas. 29.9% and to transfer to the credit of School Dist. #32, Douglas Co. Kas. 70.1% of the money in his office now, or that may hereafter come into his office, belonging to School Dist. #66, Douglas Co. Kas.
