Be It Resolved; On this 12th day of May, 1926 by the Boards of County Commissioners of Leavenworth and Douglas Counties in joint session, that the County Engineer of Douglas County and the County Engineer of Leavenworth County be instructed to prepare plans, specifications and estimates for the repair of the main river spans of that bridge across the Kansas river between Douglas and Leavenworth counties, commonly called the Eudora Bridge and submit the same to the State Highway Engineer for approval. The specifications shall provide in the alternative for creosoted wood and steel stringers.
