CONCERNING SLIGHT CHANGE IN LOCATION OF ROAD NO. 99

WHEREAS it becomes necessary to make a slight change in the location of Road No.99 where some crosses Elk Creek in the East  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$  of the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 35 - T.13S. - R.17E. it is

ORDERED that due to this change in location of road the County acquire 62/100 acre of land for new right of way and return 6/10 acre, being the vacated right of way, to the same real estate and also,

ORDERED, That the damage to the 23/100 acre of land, by being cut off from field, be included in the amount of claim, there-fore
