RESOLUTION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF EARTHWORK AND CULVERTS ON THE SOUTH FIVE MILES OF THE RED STAR ROUTE OR STATE HIGHWAY ROAD NUMBER SIXTEEN.

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BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular session this minth day of June 1926 that

WHEREAS the plans and specifications as provided by law have been made and submitted to the State Highway Commission and approved by them for earthwork and culverts on about five miles of road located in Douglas County, Kansas and being on State Highway No.16 and being described as follows:

Commencing on the South line.of Douglas County in the center of Section 14, Township 15 and Range 19 and extending North through Sections 14, 11 and 2 in Township 15, Range 19 and Sections 35 and 25 in Township 14, Range 19.

WHEREAS said plans and specifications as approved by the State Highway Commission are now on file in the office of the County Clerk of Douglas County, Kansas as provided by law and

WHEREAS said plans and specifications call for an expenditure of a sum in excess of one thousand (31,000.00) dollars,

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas that the construction of earthwork and culverts on said road as described by said plans and specifications be constructed and that that the same be paid for from the County and State Road Fund.

The County Clerk of Douglas County, Kansas is hereby instructed and authorized to advertise for bidders on said construction as provided in said plans and specifications under Sections 19-214, 19-215 and 19-216 - Revised Statutes of Kansas, 1923.
