NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Notice is hereby given that sealed proposals will be received by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas at the office of the County Clerk until 2:00 P.M. July 7, 1926 for the construction of earthwork and culverts on about five miles of road on State Road No. 16 (Red Star Route) in Douglas County, Kansas.

Plans and specifications are now on file in the office of the County Clerk and may be obtained by bidders. A certified check of five percent of the amount, payable to the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners, must accompany each bid. These checks shall be forfeited if the successful bidder fails for ten days to furnish bond and enter into contract as described by law.

The Board of County Commissioners reserves the right to reject any or all bids or parts of bids.

ORDER OF COUNTY BOARD.

Be it ordered by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas in regular session this 16th. day of June, 1926, and in compliance with Section 68-114 Revised Statutes of Kansas, 1923, and it having developed that certain owners of land on State Road, number 16, the same being Federal Highway, number 50 South, in Douglas County, Kansas, have refused to sell land under said Section to Douglas County, Kansas; that said land belonging to said people and being hereinafter described shall be taken by said County by its right of eminent domain and said land shall be viewed by said Board of County Commissioners on the 12th. of July, 1926, and said commissioners shall determine the amount of damages and proceed entirely in accordance with Section 68-114 Revised Statutes of Kansas, 1923 and the laws of the State of Kansas.
