Saturday June 26-1926 for the execution of repairs on the Douglas County Court House and Jail, consisting of repairs on concrete and stone approaches, sidewalks, plumbing and roof work. Detailed plans and specifications and general conditions may be obtained from the County Clerk. Bidders shall accompany their bids with certified checks in the amount of \$200.00. These checks shall be forfeited if the successful bidder fails for two days to furnish bond and enter into contract as described by law. The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas reserves the right to reject any and all bids or parts of bids. E. C. Bussing, County Clerk. The Board met at the time stated but the Architect, George Chandler, did not come to said meeting and Commissioner, G. E. Kretzinger was not present. The Board agreed by unanimous vote to adjourn and to 8 o'clock Saturday July 3<sup>rd</sup> to award the contract.
