Land taken for road purposes, Willow Springs Township, F.A. P 273-Sec. 12.
The Board met in adjourned regular session Present K. J. Kennedy, D. L. Burton, E. C. Kretzinger and County Clerk E. C. Bussing. The Commissioners pursuant to an order for the purpose of obtaining land for road purposes on project 273A. (see page 239) met at the place of meeting in Willow Springs Township as set out in road notice page 240 of this record. The Board reported as follows:
The Board walked over the proposed road way and carefully consider all the land and damage that would accrue by reason of building the proposed Highway thru the farms affected by said proposed Highway, after carefully inquiring into the value of land and gathering all information possible the Board adjourned until Wednesday July 14th-1926 - When the followings allowances were made:- A. H. Detweiler, for 2.02 acres land @ 100⁰⁰ per acre \$202⁰⁰ = 160 rods of fence @ 1⁰⁰ per rod \$160⁰⁰ = 3.5 a. land cut off from main farm and damage \$87⁰⁰ Total \$450⁰⁰
