

(6) Thence south on quarter section line of Sec. 7, T. 12 S. R. 20 E. to the quarter corner between section seven (7) T. 12 S. R. 20 E. and sec. 18, T. 12 S. R. 20 E.

(7) Thence south on quarter section line to the quarter corner on the north line of Sec. 30, T. 12 S. R. 20 E. The end of the proposed improved highway. Total length about 5 miles, being the place of ending.

The improvements herein prayed for shall consist of grading, draining, and surfacing said road with one of the following types, to-wit: Concrete or Brick on concrete Base or Bituminous Macadam constructed 18' or 20' feet wide and building all necessary bridges and culverts, all in accordance with plans, specifications, and estimates approved by the State Highway Engineer (and by the U.S. Secretary of Agriculture, if Federal aid is granted for this improvement.) The Board of County Commissioners to finally select the type or types and width or widths of road improvement, subject to the approval of the State Highway Commission. Provided, that if this petition specifies only one certain type of road, that type of road shall be the one in said petition set forth.

We state that such permanent improvements will be of benefit to said district and of public utility.

The boundaries of the land subject to be taxed for such improvements are included in the Road Benefit district hereby created, and said boundaries are as follows: Description of the boundaries of the Road Benefit District located in Douglas County Kansas. Beginning at the southeast corner of the west 8 acres of the south 24 acres of the west 64 acres of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 19, T. 12 S. R. 20 E. thence north to a point 20 rods south of the north line of the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 19, T. 12 S. R. 20 E. thence east 16 rods, thence north to the south line of the north 20 acres of the west $\frac{1}{2}$ of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 19, T. 12 S. R. 20 E. thence east 16 rods to the east line of the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 19, T. 12 S. R. 20 E. thence north on the one-eighth line to N.E. corner of N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 7, T. 12 S. R. 20 E. thence west 80 rods to the quarter corner between Sec. 7 and 6, T. 12 S. R. 20 E. thence north on the $\frac{1}{4}$ line to the N.E. corner of the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 6, T. 12 S. R. 20 E. thence west to the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Grant Township which is on the north line of sec. 2, T. 12 S. R. 19 E. thence following the Douglas-Jefferson county boundary line in old river bed to its intersection with the Kansas River proper; thence in a south-easterly direction
