

Wednesday July 21st 1926

Meeting of Joint Boards of County Commissioners of Leavenworth and Douglas Counties, State of Kansas, on Wednesday, July 21st 1926 at the Commissioners room in the County Court House, City of Lawrence, Douglas Co. Kansas, in connection with the advertisement for bids for the repair of the Eudora bridge across the Kansas River at Eudora. Present Y. J. Kennedy, Chairman and D. L. Burton of Douglas County Board, E. E. Thurblood, Co. Eng. and Geo. K. McVoin, Co. Atty, Douglas Co. and H. C. Short, Chairman Lon Rush, and John Hand of the Leavenworth Co. Board and John E. McCorkle, Co. Eng. and Malcolm McNaughton, Co. Atty of Leavenworth County, Kansas. At the hour of 11 o'clock A.M. the time fixed for opening the bids on the Eudora bridge, the bids were received opened and read and it appearing that all bids were higher than the Engineers estimate, all bids were rejected. Bruner Bros. being the lowest bidders, were offered said contract at the engineers estimate and accepted said offer with the provision and agreement that were to do additional work of removing and piling the old floor under the supervision of the county engineers at and for the sum and price of \$649.46 which met the Engineers approval. Thereupon motion duly made by Commissioner Hand, seconded by Commissioner Burton said contract was let to Bruner Brothers at and for the sum and amount of \$11,629.³⁷ in accordance with plans and specifications on file in the office of the County Clerk, and for the sum of \$649.⁴⁶ additional for the removal of bridge floor and piling of same in accordance with the approval of the County Engineers. Motion Carried Roll call of Corn., following com. voted, Aye, Hand, Short, Burton Kennedy, Rush, Corn. Kertinger absent.
