Claims against the County were presented, audited and allowed as per the allowance record. The Board met on Friday instead of the first Monday of the month for the reason the first Monday of September is Labor Day and the Court House was closed.

Wednesday September 8-1926

The Board met in a joint regular session. Present chairman X. J. Kennedy, D. L. Burton, G. E. Kretsinger and the County Clerk. Claims were allowed as per the allowance record.

The Board passed the following order by unanimous "aye" vote.

Federal Aid Project No. 273. Section "A". ORDER OF COUNTY BOARD

Be it ordered by the board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas in regular session this 8th. day of Sept. 1926 and in compliance with section 68-114 revised statutes of Kansas 1923 and it having developed that certain owners of land on Federal Highway No. 73 West also Federal Highway No. 50 North in Douglas County, Kansas have refused to sell land under said section to Douglas County, Kansas; that said land belonging to said people and being hereinafter described shall be taken by said county by its right of eminent domain and said land shall be used by said board of County Commissioners on the 25th day of Sept. 1926 and said commissioners shall determine the amount of damages and proceed entirely in accordance with section 68-114 revised statutes of Kansas 1923 and the laws of the State of Kansas

The owners of said land being as follows, and said land being described as shown on the following Road Notice.

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas in regular session Sept. 8th. 1926 passed by unanimous vote and ordered to proceed to acquire certain land for road purposes by right of eminent domain and setting time for viewing the same, said land being described as follows:- A tract of land belonging to A. Jardon, beginning at a point 30 feet west and 27½ feet south of the ¼ cor. on the north line of Sec. 2: T 15 S: R 19 E: thence west parallel to the north line of Sec. 2; a distance of 470 feet; thence south 2½ feet; thence southeasterly along the arc of a curve having a radius of 470 feet a distance of 738 feet more or less; to a point 30 feet west of the east line of the N.W. ¼ of Sec. 2: 15:19, thence north 47½ feet to the point of beginning.
