The Board instructed the County Treasurer to settle with Mr. Dyer for \$35.00

Mr. Dyer asked further that the valuation be reduced on said strip of land from \$300.00 to \$150.00 presenting statements from Chas. E. Beeks and H. M. Clark, stating that the property was not worth more than \$150.00. The Board decided that said property had been erroneously assessed and instructed the County Clerk to reduce the valuation to 150.00 on said strip in West Baldwin. 25 ft by 300 ft parallel with the Santa Fe right of way.
