

Saturday September 25-1926

The Board met in Special session. Present Chairman, C. J. Kennedy, D. L. Byrton, and G. E. Kretzinger and County Clerk E. C. Bursing. The County Com. and the Engineer proceeded to the location of the meeting called for to obtain land by right of eminent domain for the purpose of rounding corners on the Federal Aid Project No. 273. (See order of Board and notice to land owners on page 259) After viewing the land and giving the parties a hearing the Board returned to the Court House and made the following report. That A. D. Jardon, be allowed \$2500.00, this amount to be in full settlement for land (1.11 acres) used for the round corner, for fence and all damage. That C. A. Gale, be allowed \$2000.00 this amount to be in full settlement for land (used for rounding corner, for fence and all damage.

While the Board were still in Special Session, Mr. Rufus E. Melvin, Acting County Attorney, came before the Board and made a report of the conference he had had with the Kaw Valley Interurban Rly. Co. officials, the Receiver Mr. Harry C. Jones and Judge Pollock of the Federal Court, concerning the matter of track rental over the Kansas River Bridge on which the Interurban Railway is delinquent. After hearing the report, the Board took the following action =

In the matter of adjustment of claim of Douglas County against the receiver, Harry Jones, of the Kansas City, Kaw Valley and Western Railway, for rent over the Kansas River Bridge in Douglas County at Lawrence, Kansas.

Mr. Kennedy made a motion, seconded by Mr. Kretzinger that Mr. Rufus E. Melvin, Acting County Attorney, be instructed to make an offer to the Receiver of the Kansas City, Kaw Valley and Western Railway for Bridge Rentals as follows -

That the Receiver pay at the rate of \$1500.00 per year from the date of last payment, namely June 30-1924 up to and including the date of termination of the ten year contract now in force, also that said receiver pay \$1.00 per car, for all loaded cars, that have been or shall be transferred over the Kansas River bridge
