

The improvements herein prayed for are to be paid from not less than 10 or more than 20 annual assessments, to be determined by the Board of County Commissioners with the approval of the State Highway Commission, to be levied upon the lands above described constituting said Road Benefit District, and from all other funds provided by law for such purpose.

We further request your honorable body to find and declare said road improvements to be of public utility by order of your Board and to make an order that said improvements be made and paid for and that all necessary action therefor be taken as prescribed in chapters 80, 164, and 165 of the Laws of 1917, and chapters 245, 98 and 246 of the Laws of 1917, and any amendments thereto.
