Friday October 29-1926

The Board met in Special Session to view the following roads, as reports will show and for the purpose of opening bids on Tany Creek Bridge and Dutton Bridge. All members present.

At 9:30 A.M. the Board viewed the road petitioned for by Noah Hill and others and reported as follows. Granted the road, to be opened forty feet wide. Acquire land to make road 40 feet from west side of present road as now traveled. Damages were recommended to Channing Sheppard at the rate of \$125.00 per acre for land actually taken for such road. This to include all damages.

At 10:30 A.M. the Board met at the point of beginning of the Road Petition for by C. O. Britton and others in Clinton Township and viewed said road (see description p. 266). The road was granted as follows: That a strip of land twenty feet wide and adjacent to the present road, be secured from the property owners to provide an adequate public road. That damages be allowed at the rate of \$150.00 per acre for land actually used. This to include all damages.

At 11:30 A.M. the Board viewed the road petition for by Russell Sutton and others, and reported as follows. The road vacation was not granted but damages to be allowed.
