Re: Property - Lots 7 and 14 and south 50 feet of Lot 6, and the vacated 20 foot street west and adjoining Lot 7, all in University Heights, adjacent to the City of Lawrence, located in the east 1/2 of the northeast 1/4 of the southeast 1/4 of the southwest 1/4 of section 36 - 1st P. 12 R. 19.

Sigma of Gamma Phi Beta

Gentlemen - Title to the above property now rests in the undersigned association of Sigma of Gamma Phi Beta, which is a corporation, organized without capital stock and not for profit, for the purpose of owning the above property. This land was bought by the Association in July 1925 and since that time the present building has been erected on it. The property is owned and maintained for the sole purpose of providing a place of residence for students of the University of Kansas who are members of the Gamma Phi Beta Sorority. Under the law this property is therefore exempt from taxes and we are writing this letter to respectfully request you to issue the necessary order removing the property from the tax rolls of Douglas County.
