and specifications, prepared by H.A. Marshall, Consulting Engineer for Douglas County. Field check having been made by on said road and plans approved by the State Highway Commission. The said Board of County Commissioners ask further permission to use the money now in the County and State Road fund for paying for this work. Signed C. J. Kennedy, D. L. Burton, J. E. Kretzinger and attested by E. O. Bussing, County Clerk.

After passing the above resolution the Board instructed the County Clerk to send a copy of the resolution to the Highway Com. also to write a letter setting forth the reason that Douglas Co. wanted to do the above work, and furnish a list of equipment available for said work.

The Board at their meeting October 13-1926 passed a resolution, declaring that the surfacing of these miles of road on U.S. Highway #73 west, and described as three miles south from No. 6 school, is a public utility. (See pages 267 to 270). Now therefore they have set time for hearing complaints on said road improvement as follows.
