

Monday January 3-1927

The Board met in the first meeting of the January session. Present chairman K. J. Kennedy, D. L. Burton, S. E. Kretzinger and County Clerk E. C. Bussing. Claims against the county were presented and allowed as per the allowance record. The quarterly report of L. H. Menger, Probate Judge, was approved by the Board. The monthly reports of Dr. E. R. Keith, Health Officer, & S. C. Siger Supt. of County Home were approved.

Tuesday January 5-1927

The Board met in adjourned regular session. Present chairman, K. J. Kennedy, D. L. Burton, S. E. Kretzinger, and County Clerk E. C. Bussing. Claims against the County were presented and allowed as per the allowance record. The Board approved the quarterly report of D. F. Smith Clerk of the District Court for the quarter ending December 31-1926, also the monthly report of Emma J. Kennedy, Com. of Poor. The following petition was presented to the Board signed by Geo. O. Morris & 43 others, praying for the widening of certain road, as described in the petition.

To the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas we the undersigned householders living in Leecompton Township and in the vicinity of road described here below in said Douglas County, respectfully petition your honorable body to grant a 60 foot road beginning on the east section line, about 20 rods south of the north east corner of section (1) township (12) range (17), place of beginning, run in a northwesterly direction to section line between sections (1) and (36), thence west along line to northwest corner said section, thence south one half mile, thence west one mile to County line thence south half mile to Fort to Fort highway.

Whereupon the Board appointed them solo as viewers to meet at the point of beginning Feb. 9-1927 and give all parties a hearing.
