Monday January 10, 1927

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session, with the following officers present: Chairman, J. J. Kennedy, D. L. Burton, and E. C. Bussinger, and County Clerk, E. C. Bussing. The County Clerk administered the oath of office to J. J. Kennedy as Commissioner of the First Dist. for the term beginning Jan. 10, 1927, and to E. C. Bowman as County Clerk for the term beginning Jan. 10th 1927. The Board then organized by electing D. L. Burton, Chairman, and J. J. Kennedy, Vice Chairman. Board of J. J. Kennedy was approved for a term of two years.

The Board made the following appointments: E. E. Trueblood, County Engineer, G. A. Sizer, Sup't of Co. Farm; Mrs. Thomas, Matron of County Farm; Mrs. Emma Kennedy, Poor Commissioner; Dr. E. R. Keir, Health Officer; H. H. Sillman, Court House Custodian. On motion salaries were fixed as follows: E. E. Trueblood, \$225.00 per month, G. A. Sizer, \$85.00 per month, Mrs. Thomas, \$40 per month.
