The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with D. L. Burton, Chairman, X. J. Kennedy, G. E. Kretsinger and County Clerk, C. O. Bowman present. The minutes of the adjourned regular session of Jan. 10th and 12th, as well as the minutes of the regular meeting of Feb. 7, and the adjourned regular meeting of Feb. 10th and Feb. 12, were read and approved. On motion of X. J. Kennedy, seconded by G. E. Kretsinger the salary of the County Assessor was fixed at \$600 six hundred dollars per year. The County Attorney was instructed to prepare a resolution to be acted upon by the Board creating a revolving fund for the use of the County Clerk in purchasing stamps, small items of supplies, O. D. shipment and in cases where cash is needed.
