

March 7 - 1927

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session for the month of March with D.L. Burton, Chairman, J.F. Kennedy, G.E. Kutsinger and County Clerk, Co. Bowman, present.

The minutes of the adjourned regular meeting of Feb. 16, were read and approved. Monthly bills against the County were presented and allowed as per Allowance Record.

On proper showing by Robt. McFarland in behalf of Mrs. E.J. Hatton, the Board ordered a refund warrant amounting to Four and $27/100$ dollars drawn in favor of E.J. Hatton on account of erroneous assessment of personal property for the year 1926.

March 9 - 1927

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with D.L. Burton, Chairman, J.F. Kennedy, G.E. Kutsinger and County Clerk Co. Bowman present. Claims against the County were presented and allowed as per Allowance Register.

A Road Petition signed by C.W. Reynolds and 18 others asking for a road beginning at corner stone at the south east corner of the north east quarter of section (1) one, T. 13, R. 19 E. thence west to center stone of section (1) one, T. 13, R. 19, road to be 40 ft or 60 ft wide, was received by the Board who appointed themselves viewers of said proposed road, and set April 9th 1927, at 1:30 o'clock p.m. and point of beginning of said proposed road for time and place of hearing, and the County Clerk was ordered to publish notice in the legal form and way of such meetings.

March 12 - 1927

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with D.L. Burton, Chairman, J.F. Kennedy, G.E. Kutsinger and County Clerk, Co. Bowman present. Claims against the County were presented and allowed as per Allowance Record. The following resolution was adopted by the Board.

Be it resolved by the County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in due form assembled, that whereas there appears to be a need for the County Clerk and Purchasing Agent of Douglas County, Kansas, to have a reasonable amount of cash on hand with which to pay current bills which must be paid when due or in advance.

Therefore the sum and amount of \$4000.00 dollars is hereby set aside from the general fund for the use of said clerk as Purchasing Agent in the payment of P.O.D. bills and accounts and for the purchase of necessities.
