Assignment of Bridge Contract

For value received, the Citizens Light, Heat & Power Company duly organized under the laws of the State of Delaware, and authorized to do business in the State of Kansas, and owning and operating a gas distributing plant in the City of Lawrence and vicinity in Douglas County, Kansas, does hereby sell, assign, transfer and set over unto the Peoples Utilities Kansas Corporation, a Delaware Corporation, duly authorized to do business in the State of Kansas, its successors and assigns, all its right, title, interest and rights thereunder in and to that certain contract entered into on the 23^d day of September, 1916, by and between the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas and the State of Kansas consisting of W.R. Green, Gustaf Brune, and J. Hoover of the first part and the Citizens Light, Heat and Power Company of the second part, whereby there was given to the Citizens Light, Heat and Power Company the right to lay its gas mains on and across the bridge across the Kansas river at the City of Lawrence, Kansas, and Citizens Light, Heat and Power Company also hereby sells, assigns, transfers and sets over unto the Peoples Utilities Kansas Corporation, its successors and assigns, all its right, title and interest in and to that certain renewal contract of the above contract entered into on the 14th day of January, 1927 by and between the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, consisting of D.S. Burtaw, J. Kennedy, and G.E. Kelsinger of the first part and Citizens Light, Heat and Power Company of the second part, whereby said contract of September 23^d, 1916, was extended for a period of ten years from the 14th day of January, 1927, and all the rights of the Citizens Light, Heat and Power Company thereunder.
