

Moved by H.J. Kennedy and seconded by G.E. Kretzinger that the County Treasurer be empowered to make a compromise sale of Lots 129-131, High Street, Baldwin City, Kansas to A.W. Lamb for the sum of \$5.00 and the County Clerk is hereby authorized to issue an order to the County Treasurer cancelling taxes to the amount of \$30.00 assessed against said lots for the years, 1921-22-23-24-25. Motion Carried.

Moved by H.J. Kennedy and seconded by G.E. Kretzinger that the County Treasurer be empowered to make a compromise sale of N $\frac{1}{2}$ of Lot 108, Block 36, West Lawrence, City of Lawrence on account of assessments of improvements that did not exist. Motion Carried.

The Board approved the Quarterly Reports of H.J. Cummings, Sheriff; L.H. Menger Probate Judge; and D.F. Smith, Clerk of District Court.

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with D.L. Burton, Chairman, H.J. Kennedy, G.E. Kretzinger and County Clerk C.O. Bowman present. Claims against the County were presented and allowed as per Allowance Record. The Quarterly Reports C.O. Bowman, County Clerk and Joe E. Hellmann Register of Deeds were approved. The following resolution was adopted by the Board:

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas on this 11 day of April 1927, that whereas Gus Taylor was convicted of the violation of the Prohibitory law before John W. Clark a Justice of the Peace in and for Lawrence Douglas County Kansas on the 31st day of January, 1927 and was sentence to serve sixty days in the County Jail and to pay a fine of \$200.00 and the costs of this action.

It now appearing that said sixty days have expired and that said defendant is unable to pay said fine or the total amount of said costs, it is therefore ordered that said fine be remitted upon the payment of \$25.00 on said costs and the payment of the balance of said costs within sixty days from date.
