Notice is hereby given that sealed proposals for the construction of Federal Aid road work in Douglas County, State of Kansas, said road work known as U.S. 75 W. Road, Section C, Project No. 27a, will be received at the office of the County Clerk at Lawrence, Kansas, until 11 o'clock a. m., April 30, 1927, and then publicly opened.

Said proposed improvement includes the construction of an 18-foot wide concrete or brick road with 2 feet wide earth shoulders, together with all work involved and indicated by the plans and specifications herewith. The total length of road to be constructed or improved is 4.126 miles and is briefly described as follows: Beginning at a point near the S. E. corner of Section 25, Twp. 13 S., Range 10 E., thence north to the common corner of Sections 1, 5, 11 and 12, Twp. 13 S., Range 10 E., thence east to the city limits of Lawrence.

Proposals must be accompanied by a certified check for five (5) per cent. of the bid, made payable to the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners as a guarantee that if awarded the contract, the bidder will enter into a contract and give bond as required.
