

Meeting of Board of Equalization, May 16. 1927.

The Board of County Commissioners consisting of D.L. Burton, chairman, J.J. Kennedy, and G.E. Kretzinger met in the capacity of a Board of Equalization for the purpose of hearing complaints and equalizing the assessments placed on property for the year 1927. The County Clerk, by order of the Board of Commissioners, had previously published a request for complainants to appear in the following order, as far as convenient, May 17, City of Lawrence; May 18, Clinton, Kinnawa, and Leecompton Townships and Leecompton City; May 19, Marion, Willow Springs, and Palmyra Townships and Baldwin City; May 20, Wakarusa, Grant, and Eudora Townships and Eudora City. The Board remained in continuous session for ten days at the expiration of which they adjourned until June 6, instructing the clerk to notify all persons whose valuation had been changed during the ten day session, of such change and that a further opportunity would be given them to be heard on June 6, 7, 8, if they so desired.

The Board of Equalization met June 6 and remained in session until the close of business hours of June 8, 1927 and then adjourned, having completed their work. All changes made by Board are noted in proper assessment rolls in red ink. The above minutes were read and approved.
