

June 6 - 1927

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session for the month of June with D.L. Burton, Chairman, X.J. Kennedy and G.E. Kretzinger and County Clerk CoBawman present. The minutes of the regular session of the Board for May held on the 2nd as well as the adjourned regular meetings of May 4, May 9, May 11, were read and approved. Claims against the County were presented and allowed as per allowance register. On motion of X.J. Kennedy and seconded it was unanimously to instruct the County Treasury to comply with the following order:—

It appearing from the records that at the time of the failure of the Tudora State Bank in 1922 that there was on deposit in said Bank money belonging to Douglas County, Kansas in the amount of \$11285<sup>69</sup>/<sub>100</sub>, that since said time there had been paid on said account after liquidation of said Bank the amount of \$5304<sup>24</sup>.

That there is now remaining unpaid the amount of \$5981<sup>45</sup>/<sub>100</sub> to cover which there appears to be no assets or money of any kind; that said amount of \$5981<sup>45</sup>/<sub>100</sub> on the books of the Treasurer of Douglas County, Kansas, and because of the facts above shown the County Treasurer of Douglas County, Kansas, is hereby ordered to discontinue the said amount of \$5981<sup>45</sup>/<sub>100</sub> as money on hand on the books of the office of County Treasurer.
