The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with D. L. Burton, H. J. Kennedy, G. E. Kretzinger and County Clerk C. Bowman present. Claims against the County were presented and allowed as per the allowance record. On motion duly made and seconded the County Clerk was ordered to issue a refund warrant in the amount of \$4.06 to L. N. Flint on account of an erroneous extension of penalties expended on ^{subsequent} ~~the~~ ^{the} tax rolls for 1926 against E. J. lot 4, the E. J. lot 6 and the S. 50 ft. ^{of} lot 5 block 3, South Lawrence.

On motion by H. J. Kennedy seconded by G. E. Kretzinger and unanimously carried the contract for making the 1928 tax rolls was awarded to Saml. Dodsworth Stationery Co. of Kansas City, Mo. for the sum of \$265²⁵/₁₀₀, the work to be done according to the following specifications: to furnish the three regular size books for the tax rolls, bound in three quarter binding red russia leather back and corners with canvas sides and with the usual canvas covers for each book, the usual forms of ruling and printing on the very best No. 1 grade of 40 lb. Byron Weston paper, and all the necessary special made red leather, gold lettered tabs that are needed (75 in all) with the necessary linen shields for attaching the tabs.

On motion by H. J. Kennedy, seconded by G. E. Kretzinger it was unanimously carried to issue the following order:

ORDER OF COUNTY BOARD.

Be it ordered by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas in regular session this 18th. day of June, 1927, and in compliance with Section 62-114 Revised Statutes of Kansas, 1923, and it having developed that certain owners of land on US Highway # 73 W, in Douglas County, Kansas, have refused to sell land under said Section to Douglas County, Kansas; that said land belonging to said persons and being described shall be taken by said County by its right of eminent domain and said land shall be viewed by said Board of County Commissioners on the 25 th. of June, 1927 and said commissioners shall determine the amount of damages and proceed entirely in accordance with Section 62-114 Revised Statutes of Kansas, 1923 and the laws of the State of Kansas.

The owner of said land being as follows and said land being described as:

Beginning at a point 33 feet south and 33 feet east of the N. W. Corner of Sec. 12; T 13 S; R 19 E: Thence South parallel to the West line of said Sec. 12 - 13 - 19, 431.35 feet. Thence in a Northeasterly direction along a curve with a 483.7 foot radius, 759.6 feet. Thence West 431.35 feet to point of beginning. Containing 1.13 acres more or less.

In compliance with the above order the following road notice was ordered published in the Daily Journal World and a copy of said notice served
