ROAD NOTICE

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular session June 8, 1927, passed by unanimous vote an order to proceed to acquire certain land for road purposes by right of eminent domain and setting time for viewing the same, said land being described as follows:-

A tract of land belonging to Elmer Brown:- Beginning at a point 33 feet south and 33 feet east of the N. W. Corner of Sec. 12: T 13 S: R 19 E: Thence South parallel to the West line of said Sec. 12: 13-19, 451.35 feet. Thence in a Northeasterly direction along a curve with a 488.7 foot radius, 759.6 feet. Thence West 451.35 feet to point of beginning, Containing 1.18 acres more or less.

You are hereby notified that the Board of County Commissioners, D. L. Burton, X. J. Kennedy & G. E. Kretzinger, together with the County Engineer, E. E. Truesblood will meet at the N. W. corner of Sec. 12: T 13 S: R 19 E: in Douglas County, Kansas, at the hour of 10 A. M. June 25, 1927 and proceed to view said land, give all parties a hearing, appraise the land, assess the damages and forthwith file their report in the office of the County Clerk of Douglas County, Kansas, in accordance with section 68-114 Revised Statutes of Kansas, 1923 and the laws of Kansas.
