

August 1 - 1927.

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session for the month of August, with D.L. Burton, Chairman, X.J. Kennedy & G.E. Kretsinger and Co. Bowman, County Clerk present. The minutes of the regular session of July 2, as well as those of the adjourned regular sessions of July 6th 9th and 23rd, were read and approved as read. Claims against the County were presented and allowed as per Allowance register.

August 3 - 1927

The Board of county commissioners met in adjourned regular session with D.L. Burton, Chairman, X.J. Kennedy, G.E. Kretsinger, Commissioners, and Co. Bowman, County Clerk, present. Claims against the County were presented and approved as per allowance register. The Second Quarterly Report of the Register of Deeds was approved by the Board.

On motion by X.J. Kennedy, seconded by G.E. Kretsinger, the James Mfg. Co. of Fort Atkinson, Mo., was awarded the contract for stanchions for the County Farm Barn for the sum of \$205.⁷²

On motion by X.J. Kennedy seconded by G.E. Kretsinger a petition signed by J.C. Bushong and others asking that a sewer district as described in said petition be formed and that storm and sanitary sewers be constructed therein in accordance with Chapter 165 of the Session Laws of Kansas for 1927, was granted.
