

unanimously voted to award the contract for furnishing coal for the coming year to Kaw Valley Fuel Company, Mill Pendleton, Manager, at the following price: Cherokee Lump from Hamilton mine No. 9, at a price of Six and $\frac{1}{2}$ % (\$6 $\frac{1}{2}$) dollars per ton of Pittsburg-Midway #10 Cherokee Lump Coal at a price of Six and $\frac{1}{4}$ % (\$6 $\frac{1}{4}$) dollars per ton. All coal to be B.O.B. truck at Lawrence and India. The Board reserved the right to specify which coal is to be shipped. Other bids were as follows: University Coal Co. Hamilton mine No. 9, \$7.25 per ton. Ridley No. 7, \$6.25. Logan Moore Lumb. Co. Coal from the Mackie-Clemens Mine No. 18, \$6 $\frac{1}{4}$. McCleary Coal Co. Cherokee deep mined second coal at \$6 $\frac{1}{4}$.

The Board on motion duly made and seconded, awards the County Coal Contract to the Long A.D. Co. Contract on file in the Office of County Clerk.

On motion by X.J. Kennedy seconded by G.E. Ketsinger, the following resolution was adopted.

R E S O L U T I O N

Be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas on this 10th day of August, 1927 that whereas Federal Aid Road project No. 229 D will not be completed until about January 1st, 1928 and whereas said County of Douglas is in need of temporary funds for the completion of the same and whereas it is not advisable to issue bonds therefor until the completion thereof.

Now therefore it is deemed necessary by said Board to give to the Watkins National Bank of Lawrence Kansas ^{and the First State Bank of Lawrence Kan.} four notes due on or before January 1st, 1928 with interest at $4\frac{1}{2}$ % per annum. Two of said notes being for the principal sum of \$20,000.00 and two of said notes for the principal sum of \$10,000.00, making in all four notes for the total sum of \$60,000.00 with interest at the rate of $4\frac{1}{2}$ % per annum. Said notes and the proceedings hereunder being had under and by virtue of Section 10-123 of the Revised Statutes of Kansas, 1923, and said notes being given for the purpose of furnishing funds for said project until same is completed and bonds can be issued therefor.
