On motion of G. E. Kretzinger, seconded by J. J. Kennedy and by unanimous vote of the Board, the J. E. Cason & Company, were hired to audit the financial records of the County Clerk, Register of Deeds, Clerk of the District Court, Probate Judge and Sheriff of Douglas County, Kansas, covering 4 years from Jan. 1 - 1923, also the financial records and accounts of the Treasurer of said County, covering four years from October 1 - 1923, and to make a complete written report on such audit, for the sum of Two Thousand Dollars, subject to the following discounts: 15% discount on all amounts paid for the month of August, 1927; 10% discount on all amounts paid in September and 5% discount on all amounts paid in October, balance payable net at the November session.

On motion by J. J. Kennedy, seconded by G. E. Kretzinger and by unanimous vote of the Board the County Tax Levy was fixed for the year 1927, as follows -
