

N.W. corner of sec. 26, T13S, R19E, thence south on the section line to the S.W. corner of sec. 35, T13S, R19E, thence west $\frac{1}{2}$ mile to the quarter corner of the west line of sec. 3, T14S, R19E, thence south on the quarter line through sections 3, 10, 15, 22, 27 and 34, T14S, R19E, thence continuing south on quarter line through quarter corner on the south line of sec. 13, T15S, R19E, thence west 2 miles to the quarter line through sections 13, 12 and 1, T15S, R19E, thence north on quarter line through sections 36, 25, 24, 13 and 12, T14S, R19E, thence east $\frac{1}{2}$ mile to the S.E. cor. of sec. 25, T13S, R19E, thence west 2 (two) miles to point of beginning. The lots and parcels of land to be taxed for such improvement included in said Road Benefit District are described as follows, to-wit:

Sections 25, 26, 35 and 36, T13S, R19E;
Sections 1, 2, 11, 14, 23, 26 and 35 T14S, R19E;
The East one-half (1/2) of sections 3, 10, 15, 22, 27 and 34, T14S, R19E;
The West one-half (1/2) of sections 12, 13, 24, 25 and 36, T14S, R19E;
Sections 2, 11, and 14 T15S, R19E;
The East one-half (1/2) of sections 3, 10, and 15, T15S, R19E;
The West one-half (1/2) of sections 1, 12 and 13 T15S, R19E,

and including the rights of way of all railroads within said Benefit District, but not including any lands within the limits of incorporate cities or land used for church, school or cemetery purposes lying within said Benefit District.

Which said descriptions are made a part of this petition for the purpose of fixing and defining the territory included in said district and the boundaries thereof.

The improvements herein prayed for are to be paid from not less than 10 or more than 20 annual assessments, to be determined by the Board of County Commissioners with the approval of the State Highway Commission, to be levied upon the lands above described constituting said Road Benefit District, and from all other funds provided by law for such purpose.

We further request your Honorable body to find and declare said road improvements to be of public utility by order of your Board and to make an order that said improvements made and paid for and that all necessary action thereon be taken as prescribed in Chapters 80, 264, and 265 of the laws of 1917, and Chapters 245, 95 and 246 of the laws of 1917, and any amendments thereto.
