

Resolution.

The County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular session Nov 9, 1927, adopted the following resolution:

Whereas, List & Heathley Contractors for the construction of Grading, Culverts, and Concrete Paving on Federal Aid Project No. 229, Section D, did not finish the construction within the time specified in the contract, July 1st, 1927:

Be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners that liquidated damages will be collected, said liquidated damages to consist of the Engineering expenses incurred by the County upon said project and section to September 1, 1927, the date said road was open to travel.

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with D. S. Burton, Chairman, J. J. Kennedy and J. E. Kretzinger and C. B. Bowman, County Clerk. Present claims against the County were presented and allowed as per request. On motion of J. J. Kennedy, seconded by J. E. Kretzinger the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

Whereas the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, is engaged in the construction of certain permanent highways authorized by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, on petition in regular form and approved by the Kansas State Highway Commission, for which road bonds of Douglas County, Kansas, are to be issued: and

Whereas there is need of money to carry this work to completion and pending the issuing of such Bonds:

Therefore, Be it Resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular session this 12th day of November, 1927, in accordance with section 10-123, Revised Statutes of Kansas, 1923, that there be issued Six Temporary Notes of Five Thousand Dollars each, a Total of Thirty Thousand Dollars,
