

On motion duly made & carried the County Clerk was ordered to instruct the County Treasurer to cancel the personal property tax amounting to Eleven or \$100 Dollars assessed to J. Hunter on account being in the wrong assessing district Mr. Hunter being a resident of School Dist. No. 66 and is assessed in that District.

The petition of E. C. Robinson and others for the location of a road, beginning at the south east corner of the NE¹/₄ of SW¹/₄ of Sec. 25-13, R. 18E, thence in a northwesterly direction to the north east corner NE¹/₄ of said SW¹/₄ of Sec. 25-13-18, filed on Nov. 4, 1927 was presented to the Board and on motion duly made the Board appointed themselves viewers and ordered publication to be made, fixing December 14, 1927 at 10 o'clock a.m. and the place of beginning of the above described road the meeting place for the viewers and those interested.

Nov. 16, 1927

The Board met in its last meeting of the regular session for November with D. L. Burton, Chairman, J. J. Kennedy, Commissioner, and C. C. Bowman, County Clerk present.

The Board instructed the County Clerk to issue cancellation orders in cases where taxpayers were not allowed their Constitutional Exemptions, also in cases where they were taxed in the wrong district for the purpose of extending the tax on the subsequent list in the proper taxing district. Cancellation orders were issued as follows: Miss P. Diaz on account of no exemption being given; to Eva A. & Alice G. Horton on account of no exemption being given; to Mrs. Ada Williams of Palmyra Township for the purpose of correcting an error in the place of assessment, the property being in School Dist. #7 but assessed in #43; to Geo. Harper, Lawrence, because of certain personal property being in Great Township but erroneously assessed in Lawrence.
