EENEFIT PETITION FOR ROAD IMPROVEMENT To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners, Douglas County, Kansas. We, the undersigned residents of said County and owning land in the Road Benefit District herein referred to, and hereby defined, and being more than fifty-ome per cent of the resident indowners, owning at least thirty-five per cent of the land within said district, or being more that thirty-five per cent of the resident land-owners, owning at least fifty-one per cent of the land within the said benefit dist rict, respectfully petition your honorable body to permanently improve a certain read or roads in said county, named and known as the Lakeview County Road. Said portion of said road is located within said district. The terminal points and other specially fixed locations thereof to be improved are as follows: Beginning at a point which is the south east corner of the NE1 of sec. 26, T125; m19E; thence north to the northeast corner of sec. 27, T125; R19E; thence west to the northwest corner of the NE1 of a mile north of the center quarter corner of sec. 15 T125, R19E; thence in a west and then southwesterly direction about three quarters of a mile. to a point about f of a mile north to the south Right-ofWay line of the X. T. & S. F. R.R., which point is near the northeast corner of the SW of the SW of the SW of sec. 10 T125, R19E; a distance of about 4½ miles, being the place of ending. The improvements herein prayed for shall consist of grading, draining and surfacing said road with one of the following types, towit: SAND constructed twenty-four feet wide. We further request your honorable body to find and declare said road improvements to be of public utility by order of your Board and to make an order that said improve ments be made and paid for and that all necessary action therefor be taken as pre-scribed in chapters 80, 264 and 265 of the Laws of 1917, a nd chapters 245, 98 and 246 of the Laws of 1919, and any amendments thereto.
