Resolution

Road Improvement in Wakarusa Township, Douglas County, Kansas

Whereas, a petition signed by more than fifty-one per cent of the resident land-owners, owning at least thirty-five percent of the land in the proposed benefit district, or being more than thirty-five per cent of the resident landowners, owning at least fifty-one per cent of the land in said district, or being the owners of at least sixty per cent of the land in the proposed district, has been filed with the County Clerk of Douglas County, Kansas, praying for the permanent improvement of a certain road in Wakarusa Township, known as the Emery Road and West Hills Parkway, and described as follows: Beginning at a point 1322 feet south and 832 feet west of the center of section 36, T12S, R19E; thence in a northeasterly direction following along the east side of the rock ledge and hillside to a point 20 feet west of the intersection of the east line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section 36, and the centerline of Ninth street in the city of Lawrence, Kansas; and also beginning at a point approximately 920 feet north of the beginning of the above road, thence curving along the brow of the hill until it intersects West Hills Terrace as platted and registered in the office of the Register of Deeds. A total distance of approximately 3100 feet.

Whereas said petition sets out fully the boundaries of the proposed benefit district and specifically provides for the cost of said road, and the petition being in due and regular form: therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular session assembled this eleventh day of April, 1928, that the above described road be and is hereby declared of public utility and that said road be permanently improved.
