## ORDER OF BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

Whereas a petition signed by more than fifty-one per cent of the resident land-owners owning at least thirty-five per cent of the land in the proposed benefit district, or being more than thirty-five per cent of the landowners, owning at least owning at least fifty-one per cent of the land in said benefit district, or being owners owners of at least sixty per cent of the land in the proposed benefit district, has been filed with the County Clerk, praying for the permanent improvement of a certain road in Douglas County, Kansas, known as the Clinton County Road and more specifically described as follows:

Beginning at a point which is locally known as Banning's corner and which is the northeast corner of Sec. 20; T13S; R19E; thence west to the northwest corner of Sec. 19; T13S; R19E; thence continuing west on the section line to a point about one-fourth of a mile east of the northwest corner of Sec. 24; T13S; R19E; thence in a southwesterly direction, and then in a west direction to the town of Clinton (not an incorporated city) and the intersection with the Twin Mound County Road, thence north, and then west, parallel to and south of, the south line of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 15; T13S; R18E; to a point just south of the quarter corner on the south line of Sec. 15; T13S; R18E; a total distance of about 4.6 miles, and,

Whereas said petition set out fully the boundaries of the benefit district, and the petition being in due and regular form:

Therefore, we the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular session assembled this ninth day of May 1928, find said petitioned road to be of public utility, and notice is hereby given that on June 6, 1928 at the hour of 1:30 o'clock P. M., the Board of County Commissioners will be in session at their office in the Court House, Lawrence, Kansas, for the purpose of hearing complaints, protests, or written objections to the proposed improvements therein set out, and taking final action on said petition.

## Order of Board of County Commissioners

Whereas, a petition signed by more than fifty-one per cent of the resident land-owners, owning at least thirty-five per cent of the land in the proposed benefit district, or being more than thirty-five percent of the resident landowners, owning at least fifty-one per cent of the land in said proposed benefit district, or being the owners of at least sixty per cent of the land in the proposed benefit district, has been filed with the County Clerk, praying for the permanent improvement of a certain road in Douglas County, Kansas, and know as the Leocompton Hard Surface Road, and more specifically described as follows: Beginning at a point which is the southwest corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 23; T12S; R18E; (being the intersection of the Leocompton Hard Surface road with the Fort to Fort Highway) thence north about three miles to the south city limits of the City of Leocompton, (a city of the third class); and,

Whereas, said petition sets out fully the boundaries of the proposed benefit district and the petition being in due and regular form;

Therefore, we the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular session assembled this ninth day of May, 1928, find said petitioned road to be of public utility, and notice is hereby given that on June 6, 1928, at the hour of two o'clock P. M., the Board of County Commissioners will be in session at their office in the Court House, Lawrence, Kansas, for the purpose of hearing complaints, protests, or written objections to the proposed improvements as therein set out, and taking final action on said petition.

On motion properly made and carried the Board of County Commissioners declared the Emery Road and West Hills Parkway as petitioned for in a petition filed in the office of the County Clerk, March 5, 1928, of Public Utility and ordered the County Clerk to advertise for bids for the construction of the same when Plans and Specifications were furnished by the engineers.
