

# COMMISSIONER'S RECORD M

15

June 4, 1928.

The Board of County Commissioners met in the first regular meeting of the June session with G. E. Kretsinger, Chairman, X. J. Kennedy and D. L. Burton commissioners and the County Clerk present. The minutes of the meetings of the May session of the Board were read and approved. Monthly claims against the County presented and allowed as per allowance record.

June 6, 1928.

The Board met in adjourned regular session with all members and the County Clerk present. Claims against the County were presented and allowed as per allowance register. This being the day advertised for opening the bids submitted for the construction of Sanitary Sewer in Douglas County Sewer District No. 1, and the hour of eleven o'clock having arrived, the bid of M. M. Penny, Lawrence, Kansas, the only bid filed with the County Clerk was opened by the County Clerk in the presence of the Board of County Commissioners and others interested and read. The bid of M. M. Penny being regular and accompanied by the required certified check, and said bid being within the Engineer's estimate, the Board of County Commissioners on motion of X. J. Kennedy, seconded by D. L. Burton it was unanimously voted to award the contract to M. M. Penny at the price specified in his bid.

Final Resolutions on East Fifteenth Street Paving follow:

W H E R E A S, The Board of Commissioners of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, on May 14, 1928, passed a resolution reciting that the Board of Commissioners of the County of Douglas, Kansas, has adopted the preliminary resolution and has declared the improvement as hereinbefore set forth to be a public utility, and that said Board of Commissioners of the County of Douglas, Kansas, had set June 6, 1928, at 10 o'clock a. m. as the time and place for hearing complaints, protests and written objections to said proposed improvement and for taking final action thereon, and that said Board of Commissioners of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, is required to give notice of such hearing, and ordering that notice be given to all persons affected thereby that complaints, protests and written objections against the proposed improvement will be heard at the office of County Commissioners in the Court House in the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, on June 6, 1928, at 10 o'clock a. m., by publishing in the official city paper a copy of the original resolution and of the last resolution, and

W H E R E A S, Notices were duly published in accordance with the provisions of the above mentioned resolutions, proofs of which have been submitted, and upon consideration of which notices and proof of publication thereof, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, and the Board of Commissioners of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, find that said notices are sufficient and in accordance with statute in such case made and provided, and each Board does hereby approve and confirm the same, and

W H E R E A S, Upon said hearing of complaints, protests and written objections, held on June 6, 1928, and at 10 o'clock a. m. at the offices of the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, Kansas, in the Court House in the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, in accordance with the notices heretofore given, no good reasons are shown to exist why said improvement as hereinbefore specified should not be made and constructed, and

T H E R E F O R E, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF DOUGLAS, KANSAS, AND BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAWRENCE, KANSAS:

First: That all proceedings and actions heretofore had and done be approved;

Second: That the street and highway as hereinafter described, to wit: East Fifteenth Street in the City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, from a point beginning at the end of the present pavement on said East Fifteenth Street at its intersection with Barker Avenue in the City of Lawrence; thence East along the highway lying partly within the City of Lawrence and partly without the City of Lawrence to the East City limits located at the common corner between Sections 31 and 32 in Township 12, Range 20 and Sections 5 and 6, in Township 13, Range 20, in Douglas County, Kansas; thence Eastward for a distance of five-eighths of a mile, be graded, paved and otherwise improved;

Third: That said highway as above described be paved at a width of not less than eighteen feet with such width at intersecting streets, roads or highways as good engineering practice may require, all of said paving to be constructed of concrete, according to plans and specifications to be prepared by the Consulting Engineer of Douglas County, Kansas;

Fourth: That in order to provide for the payment of the cost of said improvement, in accordance with statute in such case made and provided, as may be assessed against the benefit districts heretofore created, the number of assessments to be levied upon the lots, tracts or parcels of land situated therein shall be ten, and the said benefit districts shall include the lands as described in former resolutions of each of said Boards.

Fifth: That hereafter all proceedings had in the matter of the above improvement shall be carried on by a joint board consisting of the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, Kansas, and the Board of Commissioners of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, in the manner provided by Statute.
