

COMMISSIONER'S RECORD M

June 9, 1928.

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with G. E. Kretsinger, Chairman, X. J. Kennedy and D. L. Burton Commissioners and the County Clerk present. No business of record outside of the allowance of claims as per allowance record.

June 13, 1928.

The Board of County Commissioners met in their last meeting of the regular for the month of June. All members of the Board and the County Clerk were present. The Board finished the allowing of May claims against the County the same being recorded in the allowance record. No other business of record was transacted at this meeting.

July 2, 1928.

The Board of County Commissioners met in their first regular meeting of the July session with G. E. Kretsinger, Chairman, X. J. Kennedy and D. L. Burton Commissioners and U. S. G. Plank, Deputy County Clerk, present. The minutes of meetings of the June sessions not being in completed form due to the sickness of County Clerk C. O. Bowman, the reading of the minutes was dispensed with. Monthly claims against the County were presented and allowed as per allowance register.

July 5, 1928.

The Board met in adjourned regular session with all members of the Board and the Deputy County Clerk present. Other claims for July against the County were presented and allowed as per allowance register.

July 7, 1928.

The Douglas County Board of Commissioners met in adjourned session with Chairman G. E. Kretsinger, and Commissioners X. J. Kennedy and D. L. Burton and the Deputy County Clerk present. A number of delayed bills against the County were presented and allowed as per allowance register. This being the day as legally advertised in the Lawrence Daily Journal-World for opening the bids on advertized work in the construction of a road designated as "Emery Road and West Hills Parkway", and it being the hour of 11 o'clock a. m., the bids were opened by the County Engineer and tabulated by his assistant in the presence of the full Board of County Commissioners and the Deputy County Clerk, the parties bidding on the work and others who were interested in the letting of the contract. The bids were as follows:

Engineer's Estimate	\$4423.46
A. L. Cox bid	4338.80
M. N. Penny bid	4468.36

In a discussion following the opening of the bids it developed that the time of completion of the road entered into the letting of the contract. Mr. A. L. Cox was low bidder but designated the time for finishing the road as October 15, 1928. Interested property owners desired the road be completed by September 15, 1928. Mr. M. N. Penny agreed with the County Commissioners to have the road completed by the 15th of September, 1928, and further agreed to do the work at the Engineer's estimate--\$4423.46. The legal certified check accompanied each bid. Contract awarded to M. N. Penny for the sum of \$4423.46.

July 11, 1928.

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with G. E. Kretsinger, Chairman, and X. J. Kennedy and D. L. Burton, Commissioners and the Deputy County Clerk Plank present. The final number of delayed bills for the month of July were presented and allowed as per allowance record. No further business of record appearing the Board adjourned to meet in special session July 21, '28.

July 21, 1928.

The Board of County Commissioners met in special session with G. E. Kretsinger, Chairman, X. J. Kennedy and D. L. Burton, Commissioners and Deputy County Clerk U. S. G. Plank present. The following Resolution was read and adopted:
TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF JOHNSON COUNTY, KANSAS.
Whereas the Commissioners of Johnson County, Kansas, having contracted and the State Highway Commission having approved the contract awarded to Dan Scherrer Construction Company for grading and draining the West section of State Highway No. 10 in Johnson County, and

Whereas, The West end of such section of State Highway No. 10 terminates near the center of a deep cut (mostly rock) on the Johnson-Douglas County line which can be worked jointly by Johnson and Douglas Counties to much greater advantage both for convenience and economy to the Johnson County Contractor the Dan Scherrer Construction Company,

Therefore, Be it resolved by the Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, that the contract awarded to the Dan Scherrer Construction Company be overrun to include a short section of Highway No. 10 in Douglas County, from the East line of said County West to station 515 plus 00 as shown on the plans approved by the Kansas State Highway Commission and on file in the County Engineer's Office at Lawrence, Kansas.

Furthermore, you are authorized by the Commissioners of Douglas County to proceed with the above specified work in said County to completion according to plans
