

## COMMISSIONER'S RECORD M

Continuing north on said half section line 3-3/4 miles to center quarter corner in sec. 22-13-18, which point is on the present Twin Mound County road; thence continuing north on said Twin Mound County road one-half mile to the quarter corner on the north line of sec. 22-13-18; thence continuing north on the same line four miles to the quarter corner on the north line of sec. 34-12-18, which point is on the present Stull County Road; thence continuing north on the same line 1-3/4 miles to intersection with US 40 Highway. Total length of road petitioned for on this line, 15-1/2 miles.

(4) Beginning at the southwest corner of sec. 17-15-19, which point is on the Douglas-Franklin County line, thence east on said County line 3-1/2 miles to intersection with Federal Highway US 73W, which point is the quarter corner on the south line of sec. 14-15-19.

(5) Beginning at the north west corner of sec. 29-14-19, which point is on the present Worden County Road, thence west one mile to the south west corner of sec. 29-14-19, thence north 3-7/8 miles to intersection with present Lone Star County Road. Total length of road petitioned for on this line 4-7/8 miles.

August 18, 1928

The Board of County Commissioners met in special session this 18th day of August, 1928, with all members of the Board and the County Clerk present. On motion properly made and unanimously carried the following resolution was adopted:

## RESOLUTION

Whereas, the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, is engaged in the construction of certain permanent Highways authorized by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, on petition in regular form, and approve by the Kansas State Highway Commission, for which roads bonds of Douglas County, Kansas are to be issued; And, Whereas, there is need of money to carry this work to completion and pending the issuance of such bonds: Therefore,

Be it Resolved, By the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in special session this 18th day of August, 1928, in accordance with sec. 10-123, Revised Statutes of Kansas, 1923, that there be issued Ten Temporary Notes of Ten Thousand Dollars each, a total of One Hundred Thousand Dollars;

Be it further resolved, That Sixty Thousand Dollars of this issue shall be used to retire an equal amount of Temporary Notes issued on the 10th day of August, 1927.

September Meeting

September 4, 1928

Monday, September 3, 1928, being a legal holiday, the Board of County Commissioners met in regular session, September 4, with G. E. Kretsinger, Chairman, X. J. Kennedy and D. L. Burton, Commissioners, and C. O. Bowman, County Clerk, present. The minutes of the regular session for August, held on August 6, 8, 11, and 15, as well as the special sessions of August 10 and 18, were read and approved. This being the first meeting of the month, the usual claims were presented and allowed as per Allowance Register.

## Resolution

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, issued on November 15, 1927, six- Five Thousand Dollar Temporary Road Notes, as provided by sec. 10-123 of the Revised Statute of 1923, and

Whereas, said Temporary Notes were due June 15, 1928, and said County of Douglas not being in a position to pay said notes at maturity, therefore,

Be it resolved, by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular session assembled this 4th day of September, 1928, that the interest rate on said notes shall be increased from 4-1/2 per cent per annum to 5-1/2 per cent per annum from date of maturity of said notes to date of payment of same.

## Resolution.

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, issued on August 10, 1927, \$60,000 in Temporary Road Notes, bearing 4-1/2 per cent interest per annum, and,

Whereas, Note No. One of this issue is still outstanding and past due, therefore, Be it resolved, by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular session this 4th day of September, 1928, that the interest rate on this No. One not for Twenty Thousand Dollars be increased to 5-1/2 per cent per annum from and after September 1, 1928, until paid.
