I hereby certify that the foregoing resolution is, in all respects, except as hereafter noted, identical with the final resolution for the improvement of US50 west from its intersection with US73W to the west Douglas County line.

First exception; Description of road: Beginning at a point on the county road designated by the State Highway Commission as a proposed Federal Aid road, said point being the intersection of US 73 W with US 50, or the Northwest corner of the Northeast quarter sec. 2; T 15 S; R 19 E; and extending along said road in a west direction on the section lines to the Douglas-Osage county line, or the northwest corner of sec. 2; T 15 S; R 17 E; a distance of 12½ miles, more or less.  
Second Exception: not to exceed-----per mile.

Health Officer*

On motion properly made and carried the term of office of the County Health Physician was fixed at two years beginning June 1, 1928, or to correspond with the term of office of the City Health officer, and the salary of the County Health officer was fixed at one hundred dollars per month, beginning with October 1, 1928.

The Board of County Commissioners accepted the resignation of Dr. E. Keith as County Health Officer under the Appointment of Jan. 10, 1927. The Board then appointed Dr. E. Keith for the term provided in the above recorded motion.

TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS:

The undersigned householder of said county, and residing in the vicinity of the present township road described below, respectfully petition your honorable body to cause a view to be had for the purpose of widening to a 60 foot ~~road~~ right of way, and the addition of said township road to the county system of highways.

Also: It is agreed by the signers of this petition owning land adjacent to the road described below, that should favorable action be taken on this petition, that they (the signers of this petition owning land adjacent to the road described) will donate, without cost to the county, for the purpose of a public road, enough additional land off of the land that they now own to widen the right of way of the road described below to 60 feet.

DESCRIPTION OF ROAD: Beginning at the northwest corner of the NE¼ of sec 31; T 12 S; R 18 E; which point is on the present Stull County road, thence south 3½ miles on the quarter section line to the southwest corner of the NE¼ of sec 13; T 13 S; R 18 E; which point is on the present Belvoir County road
