A large number of interested persons appeared before the Board during the day, most of them being fully satisfied with the cost of this improvement assessed to them, and only desirous of gaining a fuller knowledge of the manner of payment of same.

The Board of County Commissioners after fully considering all facts were of the opinion that the assessments made in this cause were fair and just under the law providing for such assessments and on motion properly made and seconded the Board were unanimous in approving their resolution under date of April 3, 1929 and as set forth in the notice to interested land owners under date of April 10, 1929.

THIS AGREEMENT, Entered into this 6th day of April 1929 by and between the commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas. X. J. Kennedy, Earl T. Black, and E.J. Hill party of the first part, and Dobson and Robinson of Lincoln Nebraska, party of the second part;

That for the consideration of forty cents (.40) per linear foot, the said Dobson and Robinson agree to furnish all necessary tools, machinery, equipment and labor and erect approximately 7780 linear feet of standard cable guard fence, according to plans and specifications hereto attached. The above named Commissioners of Douglas County, party of the first part, agree to furnish and deliver at convenient places along the highway, all materials necessary for the erection of the above mentioned guard fence.

Payment estimates will be allowed the first Monday in each month for the work completed the previous month, less ten percent (10%) until the work has been completed satisfactory to the engineer in charge, and accepted, after which final payment will be made.
