

COMMISSIONER'S RECORD M

September 7, 1929

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with all members and the County Clerk present. The Board completed the allowance of claims against the county for the month of August at this meeting.

MINUTES OF MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS, HELD ON SEPT. 7, 1929.

A regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, was held on the above date at the Commissioners' Chambers in the Court House in the City of Lawrence, Kansas, all members of the Board being present and participating therein, to-wit:

X. J. Kennedy Chairman, and Earl T. Black and E. J. Hill, Commissioners.

The matter of issuing bonds of the County pending the completion of the work on Section C of Federal Aid Project No. 273, being the Lawrence-Baldwin Highway; on Sections A and D, Federal Aid Project No. 273, being the Lawrence-Ottawa Road; and on Section D, Federal Aid Project No. 229, being the Golden Belt Road, came on for consideration and there was presented to the Board the certificate of the County Engineer and County Clerk showing the distribution of cost on said improvements and showing that after deducting all Federal Aid, State Aid, donations and subscriptions granted or promised on account of said improvements there remained an unpaid balance taxable to the County, the townships and the tracts of land situated in the respective benefit districts aggregating the sum of \$149,508.23. Thereupon, on motion duly made and seconded, and carried by unanimous vote, said estimates and certificates were duly approved and ordered filed.

Thereupon, Mr. Earl T. Black presented and moved the adoption of a resolution authorizing the issuance of County Road Bonds by Douglas County, Kansas, in the sum of \$149,000. Said motion was seconded by Mr. E. J. Hill. Thereupon, said resolution was read and considered section by section and as a whole and was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board of County Commissioners, the vote being as follows:

Aye: Kennedy, Black and Hill.

Nay: None.

The resolution adopted as aforesaid is as follows:

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE BY DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS, OF COUNTY ROAD BONDS IN THE SUM OF \$149,000.

WHEREAS, there were duly filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, petitions for the permanent improvement of certain public roads in said County, known respectively as the Lawrence-Baldwin Highway, later designated as Section C, Federal Aid Project No. 273; the Lawrence-Ottawa Road, later designated as Sections A and D, Federal Aid Project No. 273; and the Golden Belt Road, later designated as Section D, Federal Aid Project No. 229, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, did, at regular meetings of said Board, find that the improvements prayed for were of public utility, that the respective petitions were signed by the requisite number of resident landowners owning more than the requisite amount of land within the respective benefit districts described in said petitions; that said petitions properly designated the roads to be improved, both by name and by terminal points and by other specially fixed locations, and the lands within the proposed benefit districts, together with the types of improvement, the width of roadway and the number of annual assessments to be levied upon the lands in said districts in payment of the cost of said improvements, to-wit, ten annual assessments, and

WHEREAS, said petitions were in all respects in compliance with the provisions and statutes of the State of Kansas, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, duly caused an accurate survey of said improvements to be made and the profiles thereof, maps of the benefit districts and plans and specifications for the improvements, and estimates of the cost thereof, to be prepared by the County Engineer, which said surveys, profiles, maps, plans, specifications and estimates were duly and regularly approved by the State Highway Engineer and were filed in the office of the County Clerk, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, does hereby find and determine that the total estimate cost of said improvements after the application of all Federal Aid, State Aid, donations or subscriptions granted or promised on account of said improvements and excluding the cost of constructing any bridge costing \$2,000 or more or having a span of 20 feet or more, is as follows:
