On motion by E. J. Hill, seconded by Earl T. Black it was unanimously voted to direct the County Clerk to issue the following order to its Township Board of Palmyra Township.

ORDER

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, have been petitioned to improve a certain road in Palmyra Township, said road being a Township Road, and described as follows:

Beginning at the half section line on the North line of section six; township 14 south; range 20 east; thence southward two and one-half miles, more or less, to the south line of the northwest quarter of section 18; township 14 south, range 29 east.

THEREFORE, It is hereby ordered by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, in regular session assembled this 11th day of September, 1929, that,

The township Board of Palmyra Township, Douglas County, Kansas, cause to be graded and properly drained and put in condition for travel the Township Road as described; Namely, beginning at the half section line on the north line of section 6 township 14 south; range 20 east; thence southward two and one-half miles, more or less, to the south line of the northwest quarter of section 18; township 14 south; range 20 east.

SPECIFICATION CONTRACT NO. 94

I. Placing five piers under the foundation of court house building. One at the SW corner two west side of steeple, one at the NW corner, one at the NE corner, the said piers to go to the depth suitable for re-enforcing the said court house walls. To be placed as a toe brace form. The said piers to be built of concrete and stone, and all necessary work as re-covering said piers shall be done. The said county to remove surplus dirt later.

II. To re-point all seams that has opened on account of building spreading on the ex-terior.

III. Placing two steel brace rods in at highest possible point so as to help the foundation balance the steeple.

IV. To place all rafters under roof which is rotted, and to re-pair all such brace work that is necessary to relieve the strain of the west wall.

V. To re-rod the county jail building at the north side. To repair and brace all wood work under the roof of the said building. To re-point all open seams caused from building spreading.

VI. When work is finished each item of this specification must be completed.
