The Snyder Memorial Church having made application to the State Tax Commission for exemption from taxation on Lot 6, less the South 25 feet of the West 75 feet; and the east 50 feet of Lot 7, Block 12, Babcocks Enlarged Addition, a part of the City of Lawrence, and the State Tax Commission having granted the petition and ordered the abatement of the second half of the 1928 taxes, amounting to \$39.07, which has been paid under protest, it was moved by Earl T. Black and seconded by E. J. Hill, "That the County Clerk be directed to issue the Snyder Memorial Church a Refund Warrant in the sum of \$39.07. The motion was carried.
